

Sinai Temple Cemetery Association, Inc.

The entrance to Sinai Temple Cemetery is located off Barker Avenue and Hendricks Street in Michigan City. It can also be reached through the Greenwood Cemetery entrance on Tilden Avenue. Originally it was called *Oheb Sholem* Cemetery. We have a handwritten paper dated June 8, 1925 with the names of Trustees; Herbert P. Levin, Moses Moritz, and Fred Stern, recorded June 29, 1925 in La Porte County in Book 140 Page 628 stating that Greenwood Cemetery wanted \$40.00 for each lot and \$100.00 for perpetual care. In 1953, Sinai Temple received title to the cemetery. At that time the committee consisted of Rabbi Karl Richter, J.N. Gole and President of Sinai Temple Jack Ruby, ex-officio. In January 1994, Sinai Temple, Inc. signed a Quit-Claim deed transferring ownership of Sinai Temple Cemetery to the Sinai Temple Cemetery Association, Inc. through the efforts of Ed Frank. The original Board of Directors were Edward Frank, Martin Hochberg, Robert Kohn, Diana Kohn, Bernice Kottler. Although Sinai Temple Cemetery is located in Greenwood Cemetery, it is its own entity. The officers now include; Jay Sosna, President, Diana Kohn, Secretary, Ed Frank, Treasurer, Howard Tobias, Jesse Rodman, Barbara Bankoff and Michael Gertner, Board Members.



We have a Lawn and Garden service to trim bushes, cut the grass, fertilize and keep our cemetery in good condition. The current prices of lots in Sinai Temple are \$750.00 per grave plus perpetual care of \$150.00 for Temple members and \$1,000.00 per grave plus perpetual care of \$150.00 for non-Temple members.
